Tutoring

In accordance with standard professional ethics, no teacher shall teach privately (tutor) his/her own students. This shall not apply to teachers of homebound children employed by the Board of Education. The instruction of students in a teacher's class shall be part of his/her regular duty. These students shall be entitled to all the reasonable amount of time that is needed or can be given to them.
