Evaluation of Program

To achieve the highest quality of education at all levels, a critical appraisal of the program as it operates at each level is essential.

Program evaluation in Stafford will be an ongoing process which is intended to improve teaching and learning. This includes programs for students with diverse learning needs.

Program evaluation will consist of the following:

1. Program monitoring activities by school administrators
2. Analysis of test results and other relevant data about student learning and accomplishments
3. Formal program evaluation procedures as outlined in the district's curriculum review process

Evaluation reports will be given when requested by the Board or when the development, review or evaluation of a particular curriculum or instructional area has been a goal of the administration during a given school year.
