Stafford High School (SHS) is pleased to announce impressive performances on newly redesigned Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) as well as the Science Connecticut Academic Performance Test (CAPT).

In all testing areas (Science CAPT, SAT-ELA, SAT-Math), Stafford High School scored well above the state average. In addition, Stafford was ranked in the top half of the state in all testing areas. Specifically looking at the math section of the SAT, Stafford was well above the schools in its District Reference Group (DRG). As a matter of fact, since Stafford was 1.5 interquartile ranges above the upper quartile for DRG F schools, it is considered an outlier. It was also determined that Stafford was the only school in the entire state to be this far above the rest of their fellow DRG schools.
